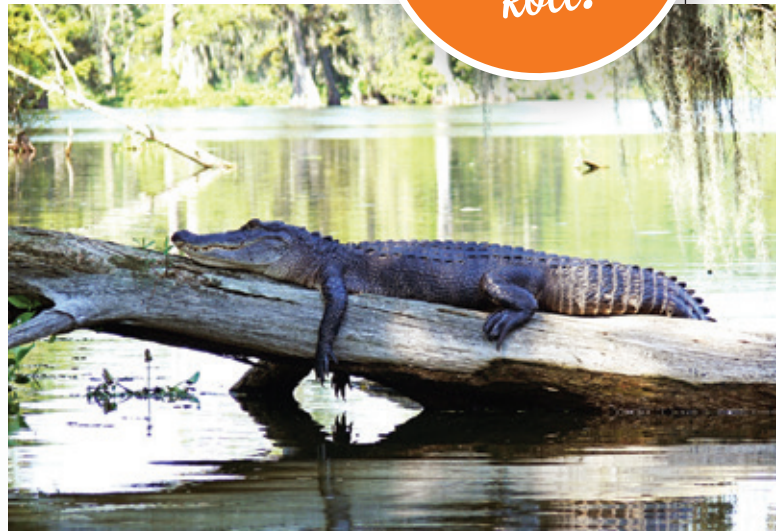

The following types of records and retention periods are general guidelines. You should customize for your personal situation and concerns, and in some cases, obtaining legal counsel may be necessary.

Individual Records Retention Period

Bank Statements	6 years
Bank Deposit Slips	3 years
Birth Certificates	Permanently
Cancelled Checks	3 years
Custody or Adoption Agreements	Permanently
Divorce Decrees	Permanently
Expense Reports	3 years
Health Records	Permanently
Investment Account Statements	3 years after the sale, rollover or distribution
Military Discharges	Permanently
Real Estate Records	Permanently
Supporting Documents for Tax Returns	7 years
Tax Returns	Permanently
